IMPORTANT !

If it is necessary to cancel your tournament entry, email or call Gil Baxter at least one day prior to the tournament date if possible.

On tournament day, if you can't make it or you are delayed, PLEASE call the PRO Shop at the course being played to let them know, or have someone relay the info to Gil Baxter at the tournament check-in.

Failure to do either of these could result in your forfeiting your entry fee.

Shamble Format- Rules Summary

1. All team members hit a drive from their assigned tee on every hole.
2. The team selects one drive for the team to play. All players will place their ball within a club length of the selected drive, and then play their own ball through the hole. A selected drive in a hazard must remain in the hazard.
3. Each players score will be recorded on every hole. The low gross score and the low best ball score for the team will be added on each hole for the team score.
4. A team must use each member's drive at least three (3) times during the 18 hole play. For teams with three members, each member's drive should be used four (4) times.
5. A and B Flight players will hit from the White tees, C and D players will hit from the Gold tees. 100% Handicaps are used, although the maximum allowed HC is 32. All other GSGA Rules apply.

Directions to Chiefland Golf Course: From Gainesville, head west on SR-26 (W Univ Ave) towards Newberry. Stay on SR-26 thru Newberry and on to Trenton (about 30 miles). In Trenton, turn left at S Main Street (SR-49/US-129) and continue going south for about 10 miles to Chiefland. Take a right at US-19/US-27/US-98, which is N Young Blvd. Travel about 0.8 miles and turn left at NW 19th Avenue. This becomes NW 115th Street (SR-320) and continue on this road for 3.5 miles. The Chiefland Golf Course will be on your left.
